# STREAKY BAY AREA SCHOOL SPORTS DAY

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

**On Friday 2 March we will be holding our annual Sports Day. This event involves all students from Reception to Year 12 and will be held at the school oval.** The official opening will be at 8:45am followed by the first events. The school day will finish at 3:05pm.

**When:** Monday 2 March 2018

**Start time:** 8:45am

**Where:** Streaky Bay Area School Oval.

Students will need to go to their **Home Class** so that the roll can be taken. After the roll call all students will then gather in their age groups with accompanying staff for the official opening. If your child is late or absent on Friday 2 March, please contact the school on 86261202 to pass on this information. Buses will run as normal on the day.

Throughout the day the students will participate alongside their age group peers in a variety of individual and team events. A programme and staff supervision details will be made available from class teachers. The carnival concludes with relay events where the house teams face off to try and win the overall championship. Points to teams are awarded for each event that a student participates in and extra points for a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>. Participation is the key. The more students become involved the more points they gain.

On the day your child will need:

- Appropriate footwear for athletics as **shoes must be worn for all events**
- A wide brim hat
- Sunscreen (This will be provided on the day)
- Appropriate clothing in team colours. Singlets are not acceptable (for example Bonds, basketball and football tops)
- Water bottle – Extra water will be available at the finish lines
- Packed lunch or lunch order

## Catering on the day

**Parents and Friends:** will be running a limited canteen, Pies, Party Pies, Pasties, Sausage Rolls, Pizza Subs & Ham & Cheese Toasties from the Canteen.

**The Senior School SRC:** will be running a BBQ with drinks and chips throughout the day for students and the school community on the oval.

**Kids Matter:** will be selling Tea/Coffee & Hot Chocolate near the Canteen.

**At the conclusion of the carnival we will conduct the presentations on the oval.** If the carnival finishes early, students will be only able to leave if their parents are present and have informed class teachers. All other students will be dismissed at 3:05pm.

We would love to see as many parents, family and friends come along and support the day. If you are able to assist in any way, please contact us at the school.

If the temperature for Sports Day is forecast at 36° or over for Ceduna on ABC TV at 7pm on Thursday 1 March, Sports Day will be postponed until the following Monday.
