MOCK CRASH YEAR 10 - 12

On Tuesday 29 August, a Road Crash Rescue Simulation will take place in Streaky Bay. The year 10 – 12 students will participate as an audience on this day. This demonstration will involve all of the emergency services. Students from Streaky Bay Area School will be participating as role players.

The program is hard hitting and aims to expose the truth about car crashes and the impact it has, not only on the human body, but also on family, friends and all of the other people that a casualty comes into contact with. Students will be able to see how the Police, Ambulance, SES and the Country Fire Service work together. Media may also be present. This demonstration, known as Exercise Rural Road Crash, will be followed by a discussion panel where students will be able to ask questions and speak one on one with emergency services personnel. It is anticipated that the exercise will run for about 2 hours. It will start at 10.00am.

This program is designed to educate young people who have just obtained or are about to obtain their drivers licences about serious road crashes and the

consequences of combining alcohol or drugs when driving. The demonstration may be distressing to any student who has experienced the loss of a loved one in a motor vehicle collision. It is therefore not compulsory for the student to attend. If you do not want your child to attend please let Mischa or myself know.
