### **COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL DRUG AWARENESS AND EDUCATION SESSIONS:**

On Thursday 26 October the South Australian Network of Drug & Alcohol Services (SANDAS) and West Coast Youth Services (WCYS) will be running a community information evening and discussion forum from 6:30pm at the Community Sports Complex. The forum will offer current information about drug and alcohol use and associated risks. It will give community members and families up to date information, resources and a chance to discuss concerns and learn about resources and supports available. A light supper, tea and coffee will be supplied. We encourage any interested parents, carers and community members to attend.

SANDAS and WCYS will also be running education sessions for students from year 7 to year 12 within the school on Friday 27 October. Their sessions will cover information about mental health, related risks of drug and alcohol use and harm minimisation.

The SANDAS and WCYS Drug & Alcohol education and information sessions have been coordinated through the work of the Streaky Bay & District Drug Awareness Action Team. This group is made up of community members from Mid West Health, the local Council, West Coast Hawks Football & Netball Clubs, the Streaky Bay Area School and SA Police.

We are fortunate to have been able to attract the support of SANDAS and WCYS and look forward to their visit.
