## 2017 School Magazine

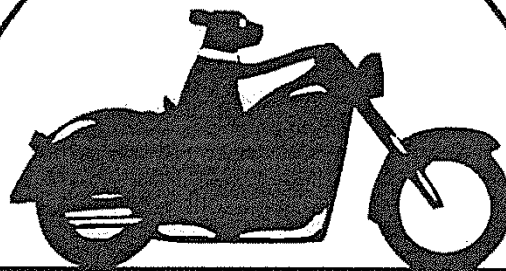
