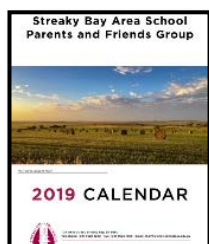
FRESH ORGANIC VEGETABLES FOR SALE

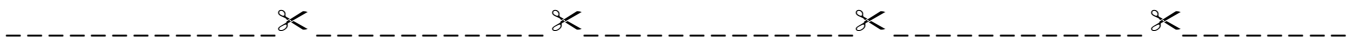
2018 School Magazine

Streaky Bay InStep Dance

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

RE: 2019 Instep Enrolments

Over the last 7 years, the Instep Committee has worked tirelessly to engage visiting artists and provide students and teachers with professional development opportunities. In 2019 Instep would again like to offer these opportunities, however in order to do this a strong commitment from parents and the students involved in the workshops will be required. If your child is born in or before 2011 (turning 8 or over in 2019), please carefully read the information below before you enrol.

For the 2019 dance season, Emma and Piter from The Dance Pad will be returning to work with Instep students aged 8 and over. As Emma and Piter run a full time dance school in Adelaide, they have limited opportunities to visit Streaky Bay and have kindly scheduled in the following two visits:

Visit 1 – April 2019

15 to the 18 April – please note these workshops will be held in the **first week of the April school holidays the week before Easter (Good Friday is the 19th April).**

Visit 2 – June 2019

17 to the 21 June - workshops will be held during **week 9 of school term 2.**

Please note groups for the 2019 Instep season will be formed from the students that attend both sets of the workshops. The groups may be mixed ages and will be set by the professional artists.

Emma and Piter will be choreographing routines for Instep students during their brief Christmas break which means Instep requires student numbers by the 24 December 2018.

If your child wishes to participate in dance in 2019 and you as a parent/caregiver can commit to the workshop dates, please see Toni Foster for an enrolment form and return in person to: Kassy Capurso or Toni Foster or via mail to Instep, PO Box 213, Streaky Bay SA 5680 prior to COB on Monday the 24 December, 2019. Student fees will remain at \$90 per term, for students aged 8 and over participating in the professional development workshops. **For those students unable to commit to the workshops, a separate group will be formed and a routine choreographed by a volunteer teacher. Fees will be \$70.00 per term, and again the groups may contain mixed ages.**

If your child will be under the age of 8 in 2019, they will be participating in the junior Instep program as per previous years at a cost of \$70.00 per term. Please see Toni Foster for an enrolment form for these students and return to either Toni Foster or Kassy Capurso, or per above address. Students must be attending preschool or above to enrol. Fees will be due during the week of the April holiday workshops.

Instep welcomes the enrolment of boys, however at this stage a separate boys group will only run if there is enough interest and a parent/caregiver volunteers their time.

The End of Year concert will be held near the end of Term 3 on the 20-21 September 2019. We look forward to a fun and exciting season. Please like the ***Instep Facebook page*** for updates and news.
