## WATOTO CHILDREN'S CHOIR

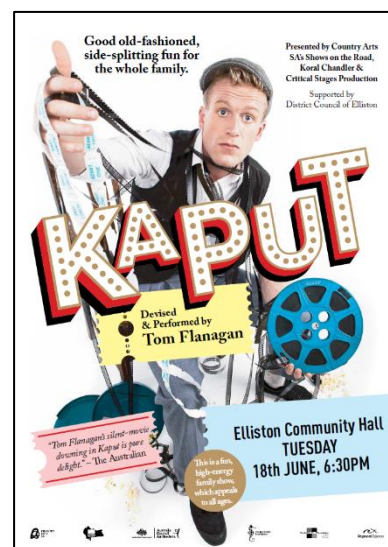
