Parents were recently emailed a link and survey code to access the 2020 Streaky Bay Area School Parent Opinion Survey online. We were very efficient in getting this survey out to parents, and in the meantime our Department's Data and Reporting team decided to host the parent survey centrally to remove the additional administration workload for schools. So far we are pleased to already have 28 parent responses to our school survey, parents can choose to do both or either of the surveys - the Department's Parent Engagement survey is based on the school survey but also has different directed questions around the school improvement model.

Parents will receive the link to the Parent Engagement Survey from our Department on Monday 7 September, this survey will be open for three weeks. The Streaky Bay Parent Opinion Survey closes Friday 18 September. All responses are completely confidential. We apologise for the confusion and overload of survey requests.
