UNIFORM & ICT/MOBILE PHONE POLICIES

The Uniform and ICT/Mobile Phone policy reviews occurred this morning. A number of changes to the policies have been recommended, some significant changes include; Uniform Policy – shorts being required to be an appropriate length and design, Extra Curricula clothing being removed from the policy - not being acceptable (this includes SAPSASA clothing), Facial jewellery remains as not allowed. Mobile Phone/ICT policy – Mobile phones are not to be used by students in school, if they are brought to school they need to be turned off and securely stored and returned at the end of the day, Senior School students under direct supervision can be allowed use to support their educational program. In next week's fortnightly newsletter an updated draft of these policies will be published, Governing Council will be meeting in the coming weeks to ratify these policies.

SCHOOL POOL SWIMMING SEASON

We are pleased to announce that the School & Community Pool will be opening from Friday 13 November. This season, COVID 19 regulations will be in place with all life guards trained as COVID Marshals.

A reminder that children under the age of 8 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.

We ask that pool users access the public car parking in front of the pool and gym area only.

Please note also that dogs are strictly prohibited on school grounds.

Pool entry payment must be made to the lifeguard in charge prior to entering the pool.

Non-toilet trained children must wear a suitable swimming nappy at all times.

We aim to have the pool operational through until the end of Term 1 if the weather remains warm.

Fees for 2020/21 are as follows: MEMBERSHIPS PAYABLE TO THE SCHOOL FRONT OFFICE.

- Child single \$40.00 (Membership)
- Adult single \$60.00 (Membership)
- Family \$100.00 (Membership - 2 payments only)
- Child \$4.00 Adult \$4.00 (Casual entry) No payment = no entry.

Please note: *Adults accompanying children at the pool but not swimming also need to pay the entry fee.*

- Pool hire \$33.00 inclusive of GST (Per hour)
