Hello Everyone,

Governor of South Australia visits

Her Excellency the Honourable Frances Adamson AC, Governor of South Australia and her husband, Mr Rod Bunten (Former Mathematics and Physics Teacher) visited the

school on Wednesday 14 August.

The purpose of her visit is so that the Governor can promote and encourage discussions on civics and citizenship, her role as the Governor and leadership.

Her Excellency has served as Australia's Ambassador to China and earlier in her career served twice in the Australian High Commission in London. In 2016, Her Excellency was appointed head of the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade. She has also been International Adviser to the Prime Minister and Chief of Staff to the Foreign Minister and Defence Minister.

Her Excellency engaged directly with the school's young people, to learn firsthand of their ambitions and concerns, and to encourage and support them in pursuing leadership opportunities and their goals. Her Excellency met with

Governing Council Chairperson, Mrs Courtney Faulkner, School Captains, Miss Ava Brace and Mr Ryan Brougham, Rural Youth Ambassador Miss Mia Roberts, members of the Senior School 'Your Voice Matters Group', SRC representatives and students aligned to the Children's University art project.

We took this opportunity for Her Excellency to unveil the newly painted mural by our Year 3-6 students, under the guidance of Wirangu Artist, Ms Susie Betts. The mural depicts locally found plants that have specific uses with the Wirangu names highlighted.
