### YONDR PHONE POUCH RETURN



Reminder: all Year **6-10 students** issued with a Yondr pouch are required to return their pouch on Thursday 12 December.

Students leaving school earlier than the timeline above, are required to hand their Yondr pouch back on their final day of their schooling.

At the start of the 2024 school year, all students from Year 6-12, were issued with a Yondr phone pouch to support the state-wide ban on mobile devices in schools. As communicated at the commencement of the year, each student was issued with a unique numbered pouch. **Upon handing them in by the due date the number will need to match the pouch issued in their name. If the pouch is damaged, and or not returned the student will be issued with an invoice of \$35 and required to pay for a replacement pouch.**

This information has been shared with the students and they are aware of the expectations and responsibilities associated with the phone pouches. I ask parents and caregivers to speak to your child/ren to remind them of the Yondr pouch hand in requirements.

When school resumes in the 2025, the process will recommence as per this year.
