# STREAKY BAY AREA SCHOOL 2025 SPORTS DAY

On **Friday 28 March**, we will be holding our **Sports Day. This event involves all students from Reception to Year 12** and will be held at school. The official opening will be at 8:50am and the school day will finish at 3:05pm.

Students will need to go to their home group at 8:45am for the roll call, after which they will gather in their house bays for the official opening. This will be followed by the first events from 9:00am.

Throughout the day the students will participate alongside their age group peers in a variety of individual and team events. A program will be in next week's newsletter. The carnival concludes with relay events where the house teams face off to try and win the overall championship. Points to teams are awarded for each event that a student participates in and extra points for a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>. Participation is the key. The more students become involved the more points they gain.

On the day your child will need:

- Appropriate footwear for athletics as shoes must be worn
- A wide brim hat
- Sunscreen (However, students will have access to this on the day)
- Appropriate clothing in team colours. Singlets are not acceptable (for example Bonds, basketball and football tops)
- Water bottle
- Packed lunch or money to purchase from the P&F and SRC stalls.

At the conclusion of the carnival, we will conduct the presentations. If the carnival finishes early, students will be only able to leave if their parents are present and have informed class teachers. All other students will wait in their home class until 3:05pm.
